## PROGRAM UPDATES FOR IEEE 2011 AP-S/URSI

Please be aware of the following amendments to the information in your Conference Program Guide:

- **Conference Badge:** Remember to wear your conference badge at all times, as it often serves as your entry to conference events, such as the Welcome Reception on Sunday, July 3 and the Salmon Bake and Barbecue on Monday, July 4.
- **Shuttle/Bus Services:** Complimentary shuttle/bus service will be provided each day between The Davenport Hotel and the Spokane Convention Center (SCC).

Shuttle/bus services will be available approximately every 10 minutes.

The Shuttles/Buses will pick up from the historic Davenport Hotel at the end of the valet area on South Post Street.

The Shuttles/Buses will pick up from the Spokane Convention Center (SCC) at the turnaround for the INB Performing Arts Center of the SCC.

- **Wireless Access:** Complimentary wireless internet access is available throughout the Spokane Convention Center. For access seek the wireless network called "IEEE." Once connected, launch your internet browser, then enter the following username and password when prompted – apsursi.
- **Salmon Bake:** For the Salmon Bake and Barbecue on Monday, July 4, we recommend bringing your conference jackets (preferable, since it identifies you with the conference), a light sweater or sweatshirt, as the temperature will drop with the setting sun and the flowing stream of the Spokane River. Also, comfortable, flat footwear is recommended, as many of the tables will be set in grassy areas. Dress is casual.
- **Student/GOLD Reception:** The Student/GOLD Luncheon scheduled for Tuesday, July 5, will now be held in the Grand Pennington Room at The Davenport Hotel.

- **Awards Banquet and Reception, July 6 at 6:00 pm:**
  - You are cordially invited to the Awards Banquet and Reception, Wednesday, July 6. Tickets can still be purchased at the Registration Desk in the Convention Center until July 4 at 12:00 noon. The Banquet will be held in Riverside Hall.
  - The Reception will be held in the Point Lobby of the Convention Center, which is located adjacent to the Riverside Hall D. The Point Lobby is only accessible via Spokane Falls Boulevard and is immediately across the street from Chili's Grill and Bar.
- **Tours:** For those participating in the off-site conference tours and social events please arrive at the shuttle pick-up zone 20 minutes prior to departure.
- **Internet Café:** The Internet Café is in Room 203 of the Spokane Convention Center.
